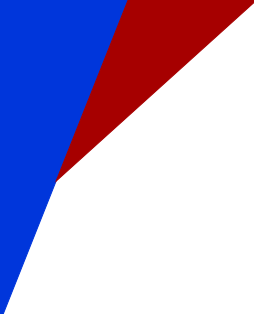

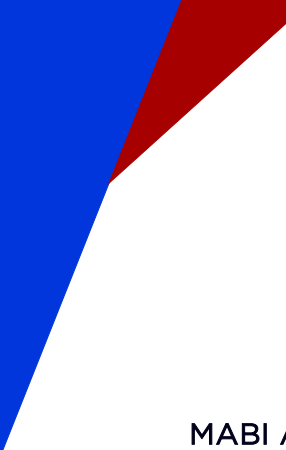

MABI AND THE ENVIRONMENT

MABI operates within the automotive industry, a sector with significant environmental impact. Therefore, effective and well-defined environmental work yields substantial measurable results. Against this background, it is natural for us to conduct our business with knowledge and commitment in the most environmentally efficient way that is technically and economically feasible within the framework of environmental legislation. Our goal is also to continuously improve our processes from an environmental perspective — we aim to contribute to long-term and sustainable development within our industry. MABI is environmentally certified according to SUSAS.

OUR ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY IS AS FOLLOWS:

VEHICLES

- When purchasing vehicles, engine and fuel alternatives with the lowest possible environmental impact shall be prioritized, when this is economically feasible.
- Those responsible for procurement shall have good knowledge of vehicle technology from an environmental perspective.

HANDLING AND RECYCLING

- All chemical products used shall be selected based on achieving the lowest possible environmental impact.
- Storage of chemical products shall take place in specially designed containers intended for that purpose.
- Separate and return all environmentally hazardous waste materials for recycling or destruction.
- In administrative departments, ensure that waste sorting is carried out for paper, cardboard, paper and plastic packaging, metal, glass, batteries, and food waste.

PURCHASING

- The purchase of eco-labeled chemical products shall comply with the guidelines of the Swedish Society for Nature Conservation (Kemikalieämbetet), and Hedin Mobility Group AB's framework agreement suppliers shall be used.
- When purchasing office and consumable materials, eco-labeled products shall always be prioritized, and Hedin Mobility Group AB's framework agreement suppliers shall be used.

ENERGY AND WATER USE

- Strive to consume as little water and energy as possible when preparing vehicles.
- All car wash facilities shall be approved and inspected in accordance with municipal regulations.
